<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repeated classroom disruptions, including talking 	<p>Time Out Class</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student is sent, with work, to Time Out class for a short time to support a change in behavior 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student sits quietly in classroom and does work. • If student is disruptive, student is sent to the office w/referral
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Being in unauthorized areas before, during and after recess • Not freezing/playing when the bell rings or whistle blows • Violation of playground, cafeteria, safe entry and exit rules • Rough playing, play fighting • Not sitting appropriately when benched 	<p>Benching</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students sits on bench during morning recess or in cafeteria during lunch recess 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student must go to bathroom on way to bench • Student must be seated • Student follows all directions given by Yard Teacher/Supervisor • Yard teacher sign off
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Littering • Chewing gum, eating candy, drinking soda • Standing and walking around while eating or drinking • Repeated benching slips (3 or more per week) 	<p>Campus Clean-Up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wash cafeteria tables • Pick-up trash in cafeteria and/or playground area 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student is given gloves and bag • Student picks up required pieces of trash • Student follows all directions; Yard teacher signs off
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leaving school grounds at any time w/o permission • Fighting • Defiance of school staff • Racial, ethnic and/or homophobic slurs • Discourtesy to adults • Missue or destruction of personal or public property before, during or after school • Stealing school or personal property • Use of profanities, vulgarities, obscenities and/or spitting • Verbal abuse or discourtesy to other students (after conflict resolution and community circle) 	<p>Detention</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teacher writes referral • Student is sent to auditorium • Detention Supervisor escorts student to cafeteria for lunch • Student completes assigned work • More than two detentions in two weeks = conference with parent, teacher and principal • More than three detentions in two weeks = In School Suspension • Principal reserves right to make <u>final decision</u> based on severity and frequency of student incident 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Silence • Follow directions of Detention Supervisor • Student will be sent to the office for repeated disruptions and placed on In-House for remainder of school day
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incomplete homework 	<p>Study Hall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students go to Study Hall and do homework • If a student has more than two notations for inappropriate behavior, student may not return 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student does homework in silence • If student does not follow directions, student will be benched next day
